Abstract: The nuances of technology transfer and factors that academic institutions must consider during the licensing of IP will be discussed. Intellectual Property (IP) licensing is an important component of Intellectual Property Management. IP licensing helps in revenue generation and also development of product markets. Identification of IP portfolio and value assessment creates avenues to exploit and extract value. Organizations need to conduct a due diligence during licensing of IP in line with the IP policy. The nature and scope of IP, use of IP, defining exclusivities, restrictive covenants, liabilities are some of the factors that need to be considered. Several complexities arise during the execution of IP licensing agreements such as ownership, terms of use, extent of background IP, rights in relation to modification of IP, sub licensing etc.,
