



MAHATMA GANDHI - THE JOURNALIST

Abstract:

In 1903 Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, then a young lawyer in South Africa, started a magazine called 'Indian Opinion'. From then until his death 45 years later, Gandhi functioned as a writer and editor apart from his better known work in politics and social reform. In this talk Ramachandra Guha will focus on this neglected aspect of Gandhi's legacy.

Prof. Ramachandra Guha is a well-known Historian and a Biographer. His research interests include environmental, social, political, contemporary and cricket history. Ramachandra Guha's most recent work is a two-volume biography of Mahatma Gandhi. The first volume, 'Gandhi Before India' was The published in 2014. second volume. 'Gandhi: The Years That Changed the World' was published in 2018. Recently he has been selected for the honorary foreign member award from the American Historical Association (AHA).
