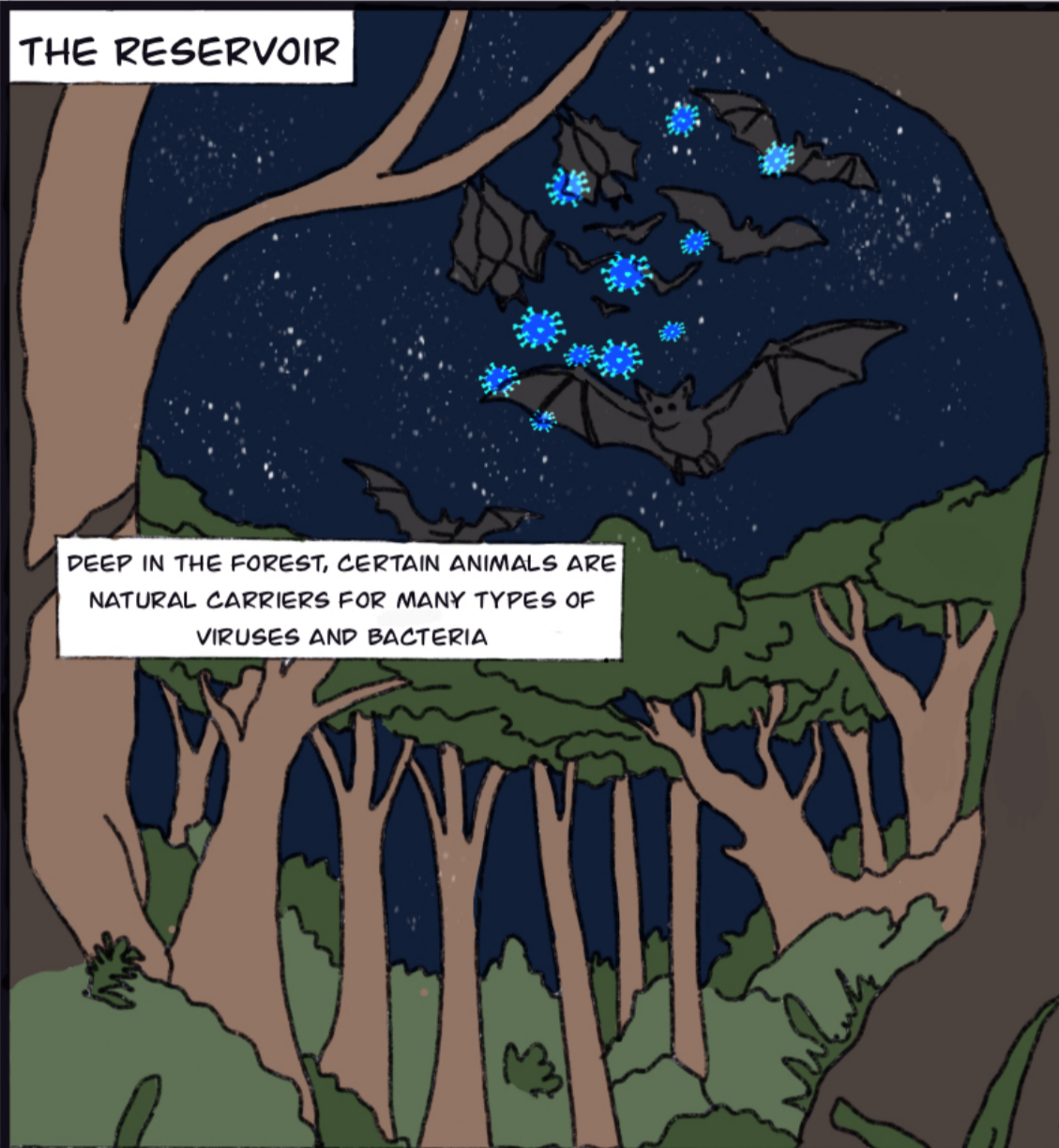

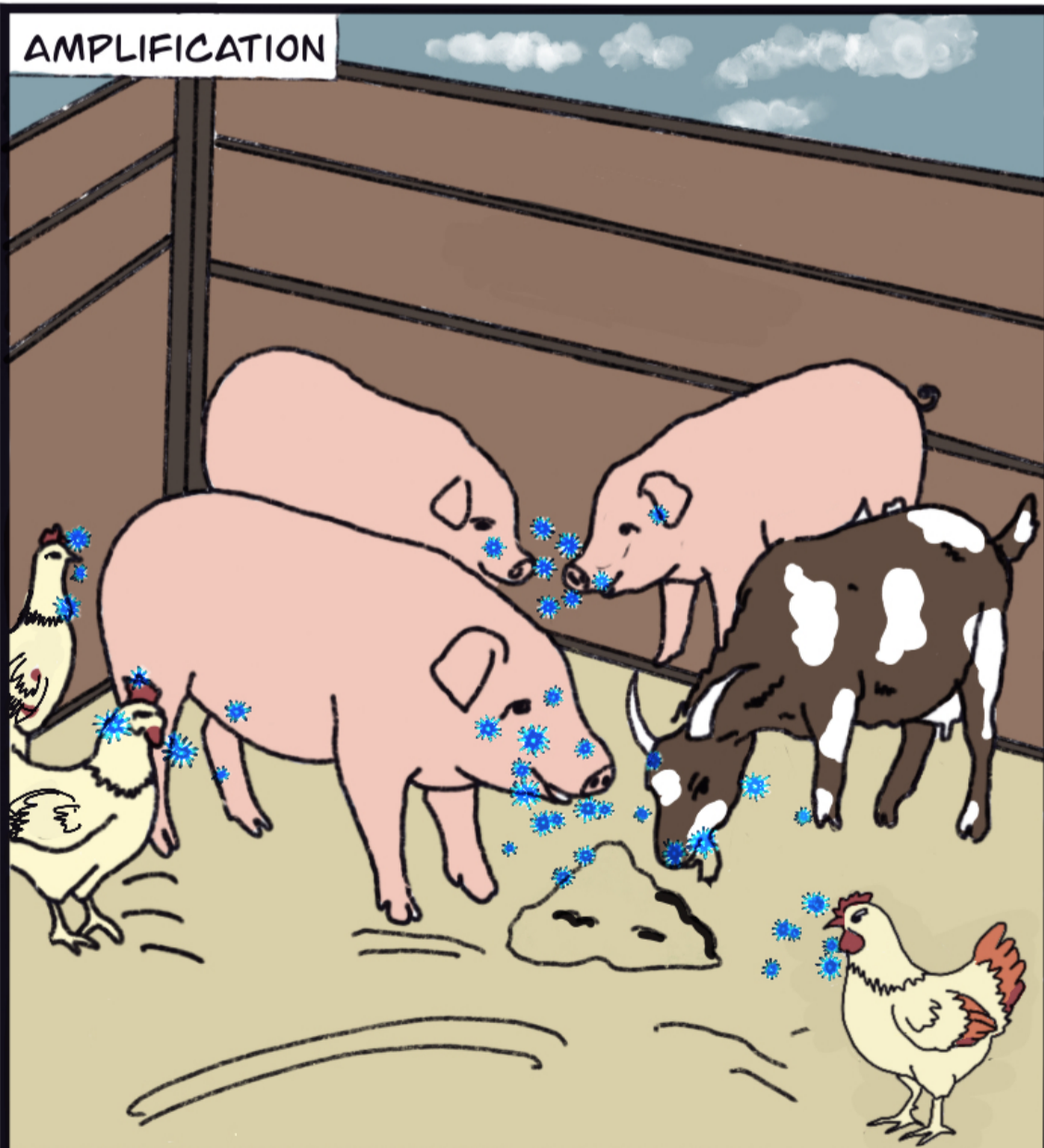
FOR EXAMPLE, BATS CARRY MANY PATHOGENS WITHOUT GETTING SICK THEMSELVES

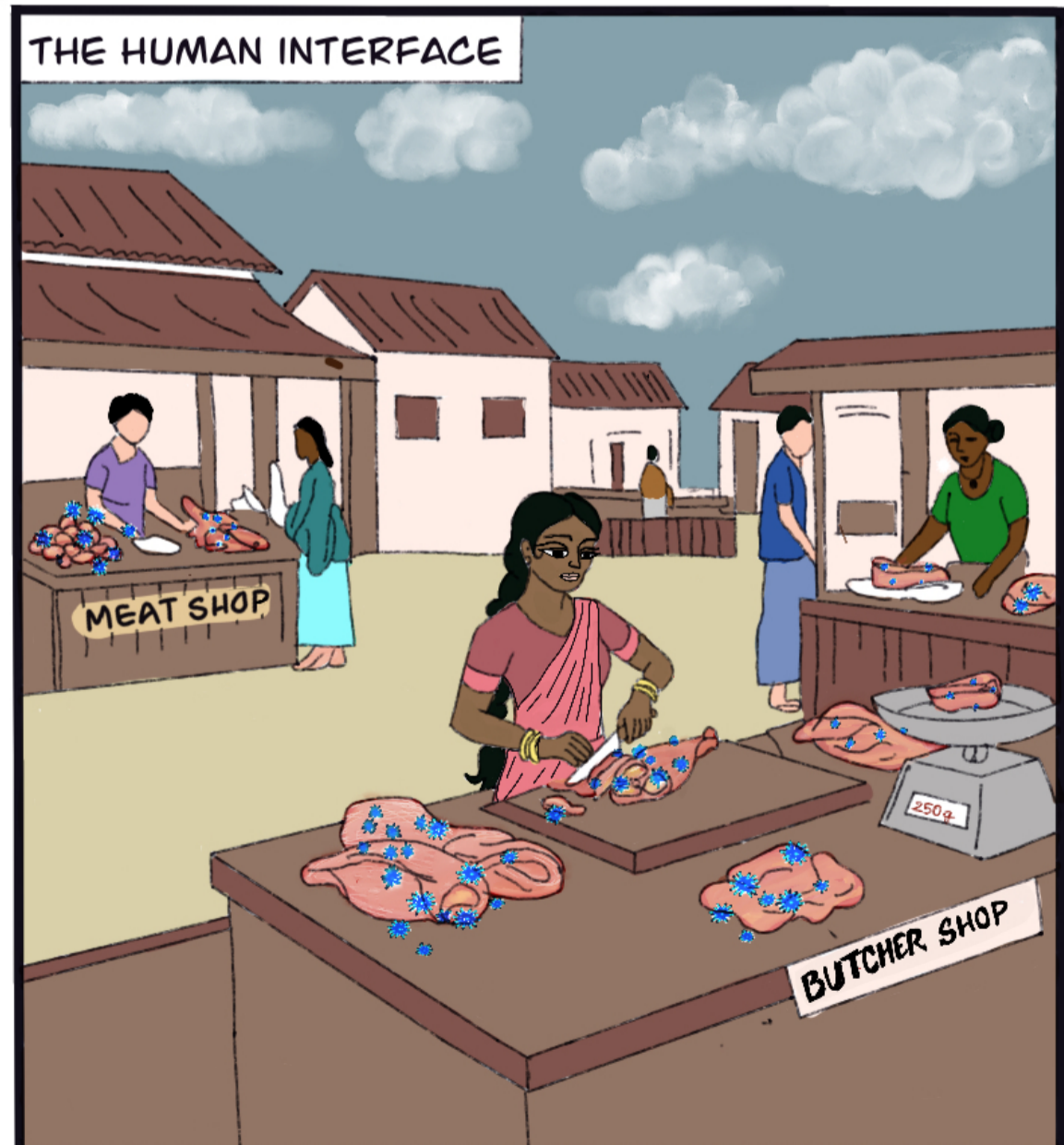

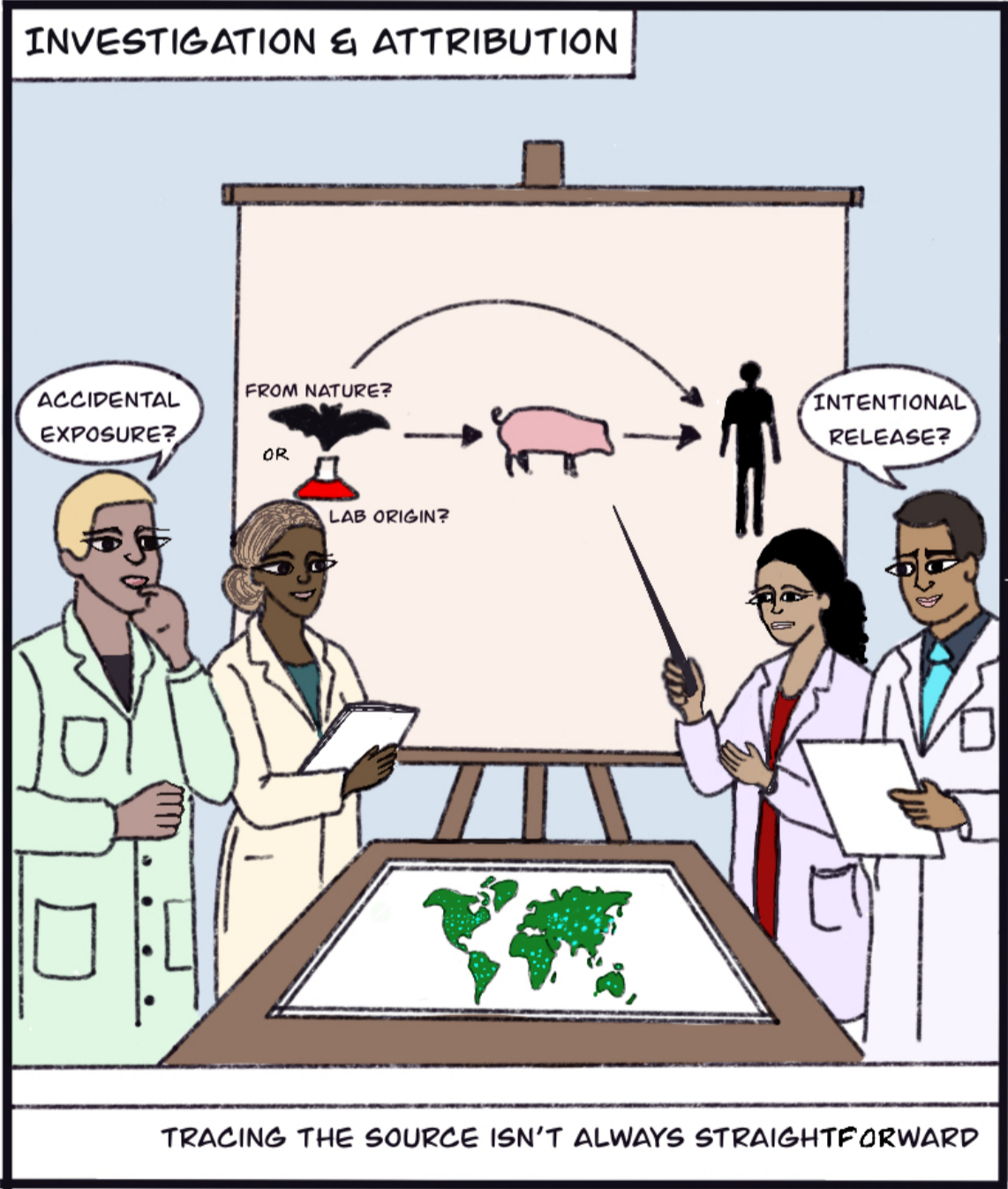
