Eradicating micronutrient malnutrition is an issue which needs to be addressed from different dimensions. Biofortification is a process of developing new food crop varieties with higher amounts of micronutrients.

Biofortification aims at reducing mortality and morbidity rates related to micronutrient malnutrition. However, implementing such policies requires effort from all disciplines of planning, from working with farmers towards cultivating modified crops, to consumers who consume them, and the policy makers who advocate about eradicating poverty, to those policy makers who raise the issue of affordability, increased expenditure and health safety. Consequently, biofortification requires a lot of thought.
