

British Council India-UK Student Exchange Programme

This is a student exchange programme with the University of Cambridge, United Kingdom.

The University of Cambridge and Centre for Society and Policy, IISc along with BITS Pilani, and Oxford Brookes University are designing a graduate course for students studying engineering or business on 'Intellectual Property for Sustainability'. The course will be piloted through a student exchange programme. The goal is to create, develop, and pilot test this multidisciplinary teaching module for educating students about IP for sustainability.

Course Structure: 2 months duration: 1 week in-person at IISc (December 2022) and 2 weeks in-person at University of Cambridge in the UK (January 2023), with intermittent online interaction. Limited places: 10 students have been selected for this programme.

Student Benefits

- Certificate from IfM Engage, University of Cambridge, UK after completion of the course.
- A two-week, visit to the University of Cambridge, UK in January 2023. Travel and accommodation costs will be fully covered.
- This is a fully funded program, including the visit to the University of Cambridge

Requirements

1. Open to 2nd year Masters students and 2nd year PhD students (August 22 - July 23).
2. There is no prerequisite for background in IP or Sustainability, however, a desire to learn is required.
